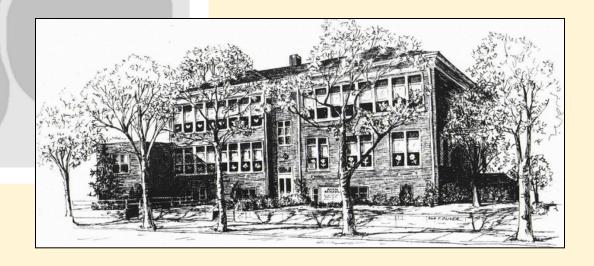


# Avon Elementary School A Tradition of Excellence



#### **Avon School Budget**



The 2018-2019 budget supports the thorough and efficient education of 203 students in grade K-12

Also supports the transportation of all private school students, K-12

#### Program

- Maintain multi-tiered system of supports for learners identified as being at-risk or gifted and /or talented
- Maintain curricular renovation cycle, expand instructional resources for special services programming

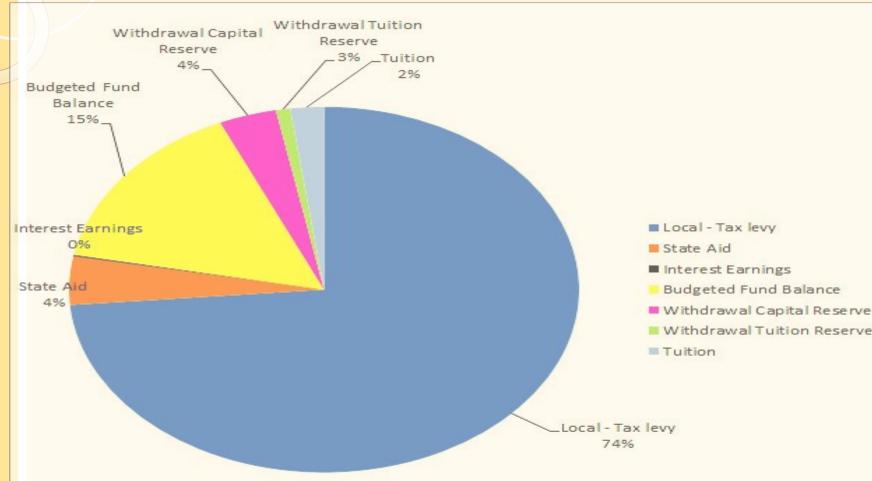

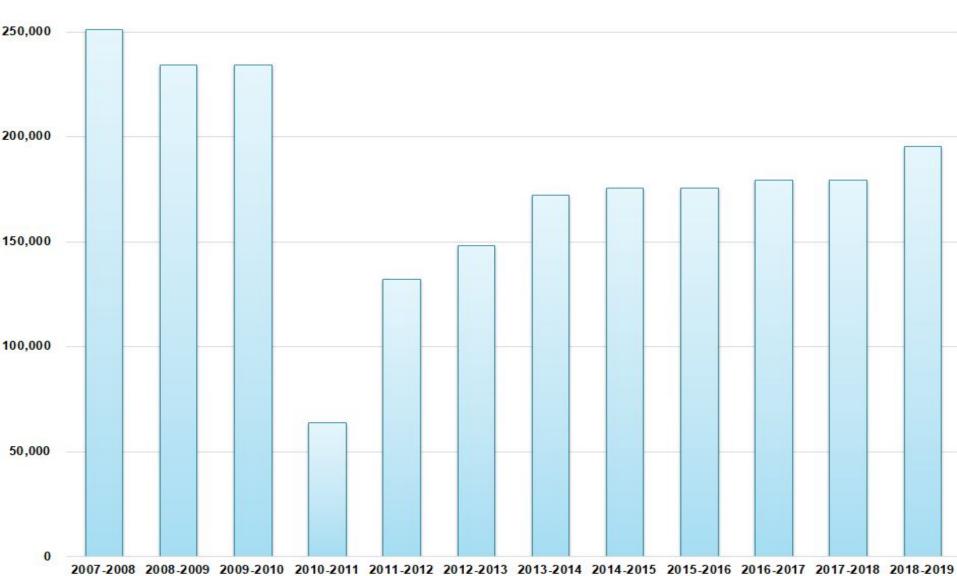

### History of State Aid

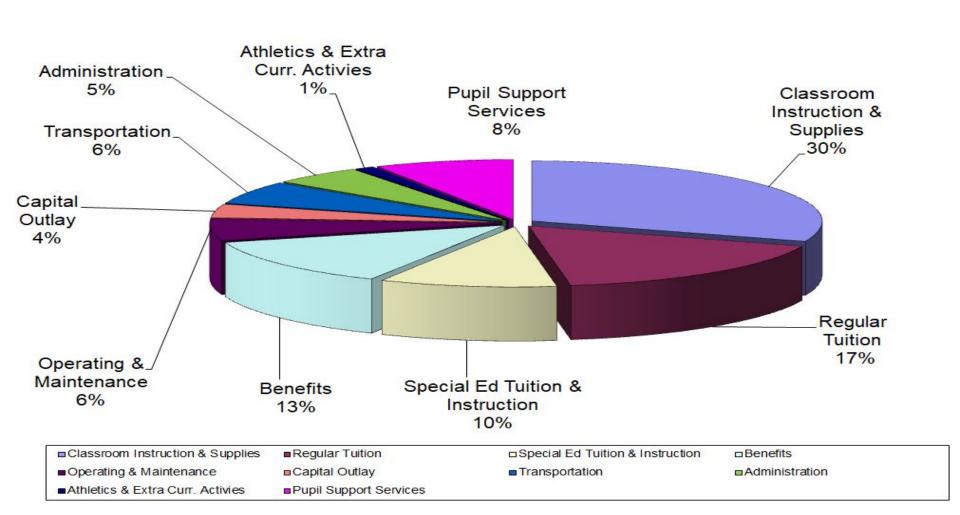




### Where does the \$ 90?

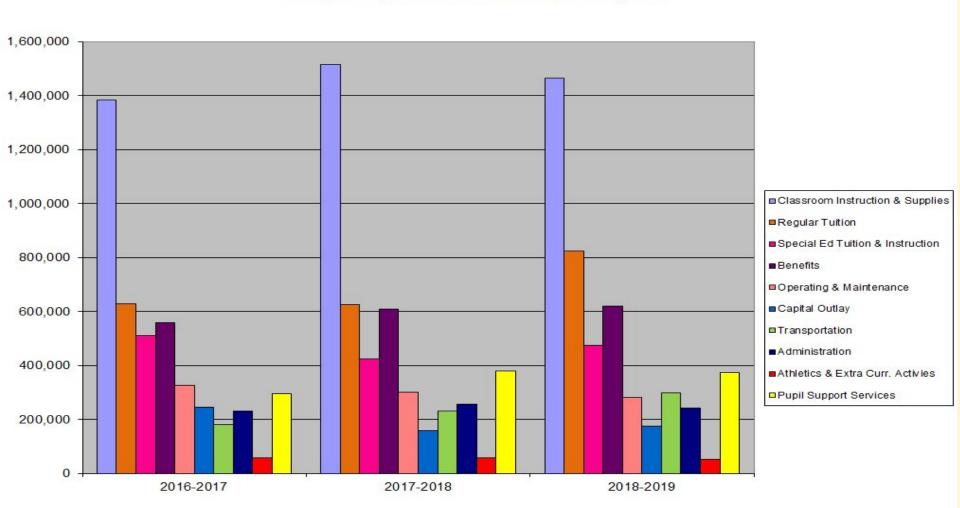


Avon-by-the-Sea Board of Education 2018-2019 School Budget Expenditures

Avon-by-the-Sea Board of Education 2018-2019 School Budget Budget Expenditures for the past 3 years



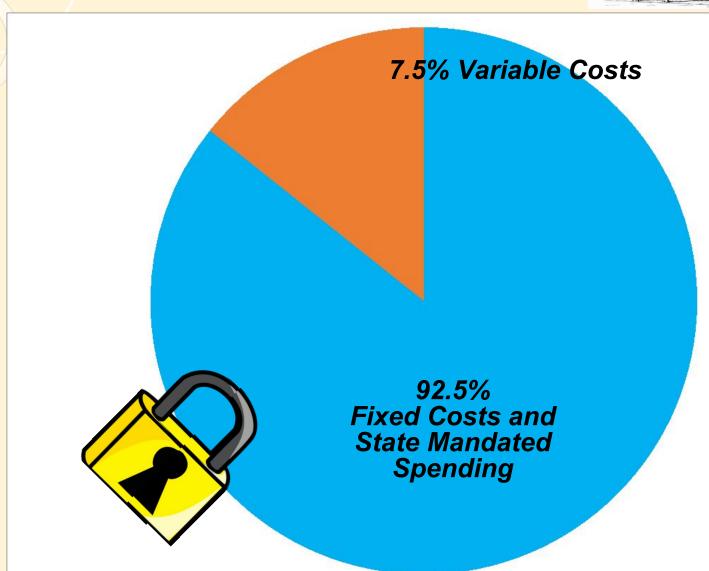
### Required Spending



- Contracted Salaries (negotiated, then fixed for 3 years)
